RESEARCH

The goal of my research agenda is threefold. First, to explore the link between writing instruction and identity development through a literacy lens. Second, develop and disseminate strategies for enhancing writing and critical thinking skills at the K-12, undergraduate, and graduate levels. Third, to connect identity research and instructional strategies through the integration of digital literacy methodology. Specifically, my research strands focus on literacy and emphasize; (a) the impact of writing on identity development, (b) identity development as it relates to digital literacy and teacher education, (c) the need for writing and critical thinking skills for pre-service and in-service teachers, and (d) further development and application of two measures for classroom implementation. The first measure, the Writing and Critical Thinking Enhancement Framework (WCEF), aims to increase students' writing and critical thinking skills in all disciplines but grounded in teacher education. The second measure, the Digital Learning Identity Survey (DLIS), helps teachers recognize and enhance how they use technology for higher learning purposes, leading to increased classroom integration.
